DEPUTY RECEIVER'S MOTION FOR AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE COMMISSION:

Jacqueline K. Cunningham, Commissioner of Insurance, Bureau of Insurance, State Corporation Commission of the Commonwealth of Virginia (the "Commission"), in her capacity as Deputy Receiver (the "Deputy Receiver") of Southern Title Insurance Corporation ("Southern Title" or the "Company"), in receivership, respectfully submits this Motion for Amended Scheduling Order for the hearing on the "Application for Orders Setting Hearing on Liquidation of Southern Title Insurance Corporation, Establishing Response Dates, Ordering Liquidation, Approving Claims Filing Deadline, and Related Matters" recently set for April 23, 2014, starting at 10:00 A.M., and represents to the Commission as follows

I.

- 1. On October 4, 2013, an Application for Orders Setting Hearing on Liquidation of Southern Title Insurance Corporation, Establishing Response Dates, Ordering Liquidation, Approving Claims Filing Deadline, and Related Matters was filed in this cause seeking, *inter alia*, entry of a liquidation order.
- 2. On October 18, 2013, the Commission entered its Scheduling Order approving the proposed notice procedures for this hearing and setting the matter to be heard on February 4, 2014, starting at 10:00 A.M.

- 3. On January 27, 2014, the Deputy Receiver filed a Motion for Continuance, seeking to continue the February 4, 2014, hearing date so as to allow the Deputy Receiver to provide proper notice of the hearing to a previously un-noticed claimants group.
- 4. By Scheduling Order entered on January 29, 2014, the Motion for Continuance was granted and a new hearing date was set for April 23, 2014. This new date creates a scheduling conflict such that not all of the Deputy Receiver's witnesses could attend.
- 5. Accordingly, the Deputy Receiver requests that the hearing be reset for May 13, 2014.
- 6. Once reset, notice of the hearing date will be sent to the un-noticed claimants group and to all persons that have elected to receive additional notice of receivership proceedings.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Deputy Receiver respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order resetting the hearing on this matter for May 13, 2014.
