FOURTH DIRECTIVE OF DEPUTY RECEIVER APPOINTING SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER

- 1. On December 20, 2011, in a case styled <u>Commonwealth of Virginia ex rel. State Corporation Commission v. Southern Title Insurance Corporation and Manju S. Ganeriwala, Treasurer of Virginia, Case No. CL11-5660-RDT, the Circuit Court of the City of Richmond ("Court") found that Southern Title Insurance Corporation ("Southern Title") is in a condition, as a single insurance business enterprise, where any further transaction of business will be hazardous to the insureds, policyholders, creditors, and the public. Therefore, pursuant to Title 38.2, Chapter 15 of the Virginia Code, the Court issued its Final Order Appointing Receiver for Rehabilitation or Liquidation ("Receivership Order"), appointing the State Corporation Commission, ("Commission") of the Commonwealth of Virginia, as Receiver of Southern Title.</u>
- 2. Also on December 20, 2011, pursuant to Title 38.2, Chapter 15 of the Virginia Code, the Commission entered its Order Appointing Deputy Receiver for Conservation and Rehabilitation, appointing Jacqueline K. Cunningham, the Commissioner of the Commission's Bureau of Insurance, as Deputy Receiver.
- 3. The Receivership Order authorizes the Deputy Receiver to employ and fix the compensation of such deputies as she considers necessary. In accordance with this authority, the Deputy Receiver on December 20, 2011, appointed Donald C. Beatty as Special Deputy Receiver of Southern Title. Donald C. Beatty will serve as Special Deputy Receiver of Southern Title until November 30, 2015, at which time management of Southern Title's receivership operations transfer to John O. Cox, Associate General Counsel.
- 4. The Deputy Receiver has concluded that John O. Cox, Associate General Counsel for the Commission, should be appointed as Special Deputy Receiver of Southern Title.

THEREFORE, in accordance with the powers granted to the Deputy Receiver in the Receivership Order, THE DEPUTY RECEIVER HEREBY APPOINTS JOHN O. COX SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER OF SOUTHERN TITLE.

This Fourth Directive is effective as of December 1, 2015. All of the foregoing is subject to further directives of the Deputy Receiver and orders of the Commission.
